1. Purpose

Rainer Neumüller is an artist who deals with current topics through project art and enactments. The backdrop to the project in question lies in the crisis in Greece along with its extensive economic effects. In order to raise awareness for the necessity of mutual aid within the European Union, the artist will undertake a voyage to London, on bicycle and without money. This project voyage will be managed by the association “art18 – vernetzte kunst währing”. The aim of this journey is the attempt by itself on the one hand, and on other hand to determine whether it is feasible to undertake such a trek without financial aid, solely depending on appropriate spontaneous help of people encountered along the way.

The ultimate goal of this artistic enactment is to financially aid the beneficiaries through the fundraising enabled with this journey. Specifically, the projects enclosed are to be supported by the raised donations. It is hereby declared that the artist will not finance himself or the project through donations and a possible review of the intended usage of raised funds lies within the sponsors’ purview.

- 1.1. The artist Rainer Neumüller’s journey via bicycle supports the fundraising effort (see 2.1). The aim of the journey is to travel from Vienna, across the EU, into Great Britain and back to Vienna. The artist pledges to not use any personal funds and to depend entirely on the voluntary aid of the local populace (hereafter referred to as “helpers”) during the entire trek.
- 1.2. The journey ends when the artist has returned to Vienna, or via abort due to lack of support or other reasons that lead to personal funds being utilised to advance.

2. Sponsor pledge

- 2.1. Transfer of funds will occur no later than 2 weeks after completion of the journey.

3. art18 pledge

- 3.1. Art18 pledges to document the journey as well as possible, specifically through the artist himself posting daily reports and photos on the art18 homepage. Furthermore videos will be recorded, whenever possible, and published on the internet. The voyage will begin on the 10th July, 2014 and will take approximately 2 months.
- 3.2. Art18 pledges to represent the sponsors and their support of the journey on the art18 homepage.
- 3.3. Art18 pledges to grant sponsors access to any and all available material produced in connection to the journey for marketing purposes.
- 3.4. The entire sum raised via the fundraising effort will be donated to the Greek self-help organization „Ampariza“. Ampariza will be presented in detail on the art18 homepage.
